

Norfolk Group Awarded \$13 million project

Integrated engineering services company, Norfolk Group Limited (ASX: NFK), announces that its wholly-owned electrical and communications subsidiary, O'Donnell Griffin, has been awarded a \$13 million contract for the High Voltage (HV) early work at the Jimblebar iron ore mine in the Pilbara region of Western Australia.

The Jimblebar mine is operated by BHP Billiton Iron Ore and is 40 kilometres east of Newman. The scope of works will involve up to 50 highly-specialised technicians, including High Voltage/Low Voltage (HV/LV) electricians, HV/LV joiners and HV testers.

O'Donnell Griffin has worked with a number of prominent companies in the Pilbara region, including Horizon Power, Fortescue Metals Group and Rio Tinto, and BHP Billiton Iron Ore.
